Dear Aunt

I received your letter this morning with the powers of Attorney which enabled me to collect from the Estate \$199. and from the Crane Iron Co. \$45. and the fore part of next week I will get the dividend from the Little Schuylkill Railroad, and then I will send you a draft, such as Daniel used to send you when he was settling Uncle John's Estate, upon considering the matter I think I might take the risk in sending you a draft to day for I will have received the L. S. dividend before you get this, and then you will get your money some what sooner, besides I would like you to present the draft at your Bank for collection as soon as you can, for I would like to be able to get away from the City at little while about the latter part of this month, and cannot well go until this draft is presented and paid.
