Dear Sir

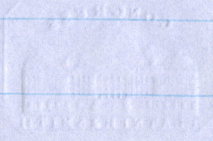
I instruct to you one thousand
two hundred and fifty dollars public
funds of the Ind department, for transport-
ation to E. F. Drew Sub Indian Agent at
Wapogan City, mouth of Wapogan River

This point will be reached by way of
Scottsburg. You will proceed at
once to that point and deliver to him
the dispatches and funds and return
with such communications as he may
have to send. Fifty dollars will be handed

You from paying the expenses on the trip, and a consolidated
receipt shall - which you will be careful to have
entered and receipted for all sums paid out, specifying
the object of expenditure, date &c. He ^{Drew} will
sign the receipts - include in his dispatches, and
deliver them to you to be conveyed to this office
on your return

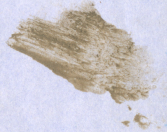
