I received the note forwarded by you from the Governor evening, 23rd. I dispatched a messenger amediately for J. Cullen who was at McMinvill with the speakers. they obtained 16 names to our Enlistment paper in McMinvill, and on the north Fork, and I have 11 here. I think we will get enough from Falkners and Amity to fill the Quota of this County. Cullen started yesterday for Forest Grove if the men take hold of the business as they did in Polk County we will have this Company full to its minimum strength by the first of January.
