200 Office Supt. Ind Affairs Lagton O. P. July 13th 1836 Your letter of the 12th inst by the hand of Mor Brown has been received. I have only to say that it is im = - portant that your train depart and arrive at its destination at the earliest moment so that we may have the use of the teams which you will forward back at once. 129 Indians came up on the last steamer all of whom will go to the Goast; but portions of them may ultimately be located along Salmon Biver. Gol Buchanan informs me that Old John and his People, and all the other bands along the Goast have came in, and are to start the next day after the date of his letter on their way up the Goast. He states howawthat 10 or 12 have sculked into the woods but an effort will be made to get them in. Capt Vones with fifty-five men came up with these Indians and are to be located at the Grand Ronde. You speak of Sambo; he is to go to the Goast, peaceby if you can, but forcefully if you must, and if it re= - quives force call upon the Military and take him in chains and do not let him free very soon, an example of disobedi ence will doubters have a good effect, and I know of no one more rickly deserving it than he; he was in the last fight and is a vicious and craby fellow, and may do great harm, call upon him quietly, and if he refuse's to go take him if it requires all the force at the Grand Ronde. The appeals of the whole Rogue Roiver Fribe must not deter you from taking this man. It has been told him that he must go, and I shall not falsify my word, but be discreet, at the same time wor no toft water. I dwell upon this rather because he is the forst Indian who has openly violated and disregarded my

orders, and to yield in this instance would be the fing of an evil haren. I shall be over on the Goast as soon as possible - in the mean time maintain Peace, keep good order and get along with as little expense to the Government as possible. Inform me as to the amount of Blow and other articles required from time to time - I shall send over, Nails, tools, &c, so as to build houses Oncourage them to exect some good houses, No intelligence from Washington, Respectfully Yours.
