On the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1860, at the request of Ladd & Gilton, the holders, of the original promissory note, annexed, a copy of which is written above J. W. W. Page, a Notary Public, duly commissioned and qualified, dwelling in said city, did present the original promissory note, to "James Burk" the indoor for payment, which was refused, no excuse being given, and I could not present the same to the drawer thereof, because that he is, and is, out of this State, and in British Columbia. —

Whereupon the said Notary Public, at the request aforesaid, did protest, and by these presents, do solemnly and publicly protest, as well, against the maker, indoor, as against all others whom it doth, or may concern for exchange, re-exchange, and all costs, damages, and



interest already incurred, and to be hereafter incurred,
