

Articles of Agreement and Convention made and concluded at the Treaty Ground, ~~Camp~~ Stevens, in the Walla Walla Valley this day of June in the year one thousand Eight hundred and fifty five, by and between Isaac I. Stevens Governor and Superintendent of Indian Affairs for the Territory of Washington and Joel Palmer Superintendent of Indian Affairs for Oregon Territory, on the part of the United States, and the undersigned Chief, Head men and delegates of the Walla Walla, Cayuse and Umatilla Tribes and bands of Indians, occupying lands partly in Washington and partly in Oregon Territories and who for the purposes of this Treaty are to be regarded as one nation on behalf of and acting for said Tribes and Bands, and being duly authorized thereto by them.

It being understood that Sup^{or} I. I. Stevens assumes to treat with those of the above named Tribes and Bands, a portion of bands residing within the Territory of Washington and Sup^{or} ^{Joel} Palmer with those residing exclusively in Oregon.
