WILLIAM L. FINLEY, nationally known naturalist will present a lecture at Lincoln high school tonight as the final feature of the 1929-30 series of program. His topic will be "Camera Hunting on the Great Divide."

In addition to the lecture Dr. Finley is to present his experiences in stalking wild game with a camera. The pictures are said to be among the finest ever made of American wild life. There are a total of five reels of film and many of the pictures were secured under the greatest difficulty. Finley tells of his experiences with the mountain goat,

the beaver, ptarmigan, wapti, and many other animals which are found in the Rockies.

Finley has appeared before many of the leading organizations and clubs in the country and is recognized to be an interesting and authentic lecturer on American wild life. He is known to many by his contributions to the leading magazines.

Students of the biology classes at McKinley high school, the nature study classes in the Canton night school, and several Boy Scout troops in the city are planning to attend the lecture.
